The Minnesota College immunization law requires that students **show proof** that they have been vaccinated against measles, mumps, rubella, tetanus and diphtheria when they enroll in a college in Minnesota.

If you have records of immunizations you have taken in the past, bring this information with you to Mankato.

Students under the age of 18 are also required to have parent/guardian consent to be seen at Student Health Services. If you are younger than 18 years, please complete the [Minor Consent for Treatment form](#).
