	 Outdoor animal waste, such as dog feces, must be immediately retrieved by owner, placed in a plastic bag and securely tied before being disposed of in an outside trash receptacle. 	
5.	Routine care of the animal is expected and includes flea and tick prevention, de-worming, and annual examinations at the Owner's expense. If fleas, ticks, or other pests are detected through inspection, the housing unit will be treated by Pest Control, and the costs will be put on the Owner's student account. Any suspected animal neglect will be reported to the proper authorities.	
6.	The Owner must effectively control the animal at all times. If the Owner cannot effectively control the animal or if the animal poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others, permission to keep the animal in university housing may be rescinded until such time as the problem is rectified	
7.	ESAs must be on a leash at all times when outside of the owner's room/apartment, unless impracticable or unfeasible due to the owner's disability	
8.	The animal may not be left overnight in university housing unattended or in the care of anyone other than the Owner. Additionally, the ESA must be taken with the Owner if leaving campus for more than 16 hours.	
9.	The owner must provide an appropriate size crate and the animal must be crated in the owner's bedroom when the owner is not present.	
10.	When the owner <u>is</u> present, ESAs are only allowed in their owner's bedroom space and/or apartment common space and the most direct route to and from the exterior door of the building. ESAs are not allowed in classrooms or any public facilities at Minnesota State University, Mankato	
11.	The Owner is responsible for assuring the animal does not interfere with the routine of individuals living on campus.	
	 Sensitivity to residents with allergies and to those who fear animals is important to ensure a positive residential community experience. 	
	 The Owner is responsible at all times for the actions of the ESA, including any odors, noise, damages, or other conduct that disturbs others or damages the premises. The Owner is expected to pay all costs of returning the unit to the same condition of move-in. Costs may include cleaning, repairing/replacing furnishings, and repairs to the living space. Residential Life has the right to assign the ESA Owner to another unit if the care or
