This event is free and open to the public, but registration is required. You can attend virtually via Zoom or in person at BSU's American Indian Resource Center.

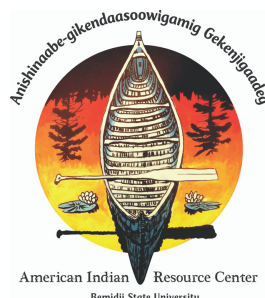
