PARKING

Living at Stadium Heights:

- If you are bringing a vehicle, you will receive a parking permit when you move-in. Do not purchase a University parking privilege.
- Living in Crawford, Julia Sears, McElroy, or Preska:
 - If you are bringing a vehicle, purchase a Light Green, Stripe, or Dark Green parking privilege from the University.
 Parking privileges go on sale at the QR code beginning at 9 a.m. on December 16. Light Green and Stripe costs \$160 for the semester and Dark Green costs \$124 for the semester.

PROVIDED ITEMS

We provide the following items in student rooms that have a semi-private bathroom:

- Toilet paper (in suites and apartments)
- Shower liner (in suites and apartments)

THINGS TO BRING

See the enclosed packing list for main campus and Stadium Heights (Things to Bring). Items often overlooked include trash bags, a trash can, laundry detergent (liquid is recommended), and cleaning supplies.

Communicate with your roommate to ensure you don't double up on big items such as a futon or TV.

Refrigerator specifications:

- 4.3 cubic feet in size (or less)
- General dimensions should not exceed 33" in height and 20" in width.

Microwave specifications:

- 1,000 watts or less
- NOTE: A microwave is available in each floor kitchen on the main campus. Stadium Heights apartments do not include a microwave.

Futon specifications:

• If you intend to place a futon under your loft, it should not exceed 80" in length.

MAVCARD

You will need your MavCARD to eat and get into your building, so bring it with you! Leaving it at home will make the first few days challenging.

BEDDING

- If you are living in a Basic, Renovated, or Semi-Suite you will need twin XL (extra long) bedding.
- If you are living in a single room at Stadium Heights, you will need full-size bedding.
- If you are living in a double room at Stadium Heights, you will need twin XL bedding.

CANCELLATIONS

If your plans have changed and you no longer need housing, submit a cancellation request in writing to reslife@mnsu.edu to avoid room and meal plan charges. Submit your cancellation by December 27, 2024 to receive \$200 back from your \$250 prepayment.

MOVE-IN PARKING

After you receive your room assignment, use the guide below to find out where you should park for unloading.

- JULIA SEARS: You may park curbside on the west side of West Road for unloading. Hazards must be on while unloading and cars must be moved to a permitted lot when done. You may also unload in Gold Lot 11/11A but need to move your vehicle out of these lots by 2 a.m. (you will be subject to ticketing).
- McELROY & PRESKA: You may park curbside on the west side of Ellis Avenue for unloading. Hazards must be on while unloading and cars must be moved to a permitted lot when done. Residents may also unload in Lot 14 Stripe, Lot 16 Green, Lot 15, and Validated Guest stalls. Lot 14 Stripe has 9 Gold stalls do not park in these stalls (you will be ticketed).
- CRAWFORD: You may unload in Lot 14 Stripe, Lot 16 Green stalls, and Validated Guest stalls. Lot 14 Stripe has 9 Gold stalls

 do not park in these stalls (you will be ticketed).
- **STADIUM HEIGHTS:** Park in the lot outside of your building.

Parking enforcement begins at 3 p.m. on Sunday, January 12 (make sure your car is in the correct lot at this time).

PACKING AND ELEVATORS

All residence communities on main campus have an elevator. Elevators in B, C, G, and E/F are are scheduled for maintenance during winter break. As long as repair technicians don't run into problems, these elevators should be back online January 9. Stadium Heights does not have elevators in the buildings, so factor this in when packing items.

ARRIVAL

Move-in begins on Friday, January 10 and concludes Sunday, January 12. You may check in between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. on any of these dates. No timeslot is needed, so arrive when it works best for your schedule.

When you arrive, go to your residence community Front Desk (or Stadium Heights Office). This is where you will receive your room key. Signage will direct you to the right location.

LAUNDRY

Laundry is free, however you'll need to bring laundry detergent (HE liquid is recommended). **Do not bring 3-in-1 detergent sheets** as they will damage the machine.

RENTER'S INSURANCE

The University does not require students to carry renter's insurance, however, in most situations, the University is not responsible for damages to personal property.

MEAL PLAN

Meal plans begin at 11 a.m. on Friday, January 10 in the University Dining Center. You have 3 guest passes each semester for family & friends. To use them, let the cashier know you want to use them.

ROOMMATE INFORMATION

You can find your roommate's name and contact information in the Housing & Dining Portal. We recommend reaching out to them to introduce yourself and to discuss the items you will be bringing to the room.
