

WINTER BREAK HOUSING

CARD ACCESS

Residence communities are closed 7 p.m. Friday, December 10 through 8 a.m. Friday, January 7. Your MavCARD will grant you access into your residence community during break.

FOOD SERVICE

Meals are not provided during Winter Break. The first meal of Spring Semester is lunch on Friday, January 7, which begins at 11 a.m. in the University Dining Center.

WINTER BREAK RETAIL DINING OPTIONS

Mav Ave, the CSU Grill, and Jazzman's will be open limited hours over the break period. Check University Dining's website for specific information. Retail dining outlets accept cash, debit/credit cards, and Dining Dollars.

STAFF

MAIL & DESK SERVICE

Front Desks are open 4:30-6:30 p.m. daily EXCEPT for December 24, 25, and 31. Students registered for Winter Break housing will have their mail delivered Monday-Friday when the Front Desk is open. You may pick up packages, check out equipment, etc. while the Front Desk is open.

STADIUM HEIGHTS

The office at Stadium Heights will be staffed from 4:30-6:30 p.m. daily EXCEPT for December 24, 25, and 31. Mail delivery will follow the U.S. Postal Service schedule.

GUESTS

Only registered residents are authorized to be in the residence communities. You may have one guest at a time. A guest is a person who is not a resident (residents who have not registered for Winter Break housing may NOT visit as a guest).

You must escort your guest at all times in the residence communities. You are responsible for your guests.

Guests should park in Lots 14 or 16. Stadium Heights residents should contact the Property Owner's Office for information about guest parking at Stadium Heights.

PARKING

Main campus residents should park in Lot 14 or 16 green stalls. Stadium Heights residents may park in their regular lots, but should park in front of Buildings 701/705 if leaving for an extended time,
